Comments
Harvest Type = Clear-cut w/reserves RE_OFFER

Harvest and Reserves
Clearcut all tamarack 5" in DBH or greater and at least 1 stick. Due to significant beetle mortality, all dead tamarack may be harvested. Do not cut any other tree species. Reserve all advanced regeneration for all species, including all healthy tamarack under 5" in DBH and less than 1 stick.

Access
0.8 miles to Wasson Lake Forest Road. State land must be crossed to the west to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/permission from the MN DNR.

Landings and Access Roads
Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
All boundaries are painted. Cutting boundaries are painted with 3 orange dashes (III), and the western property boundary is painted with 3 orange circles (o0o). An orange paint trail is painted between the sale's two tamarack stands. Pink flagging tape marks a stream in the northern tamarack stand. There will only be 1 stream crossing as indicated by trees with 3 blue dashes (III).

Slash Disposal
Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

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Tamarack will naturally regenerate, and black spruce will be aeri ally seeded.

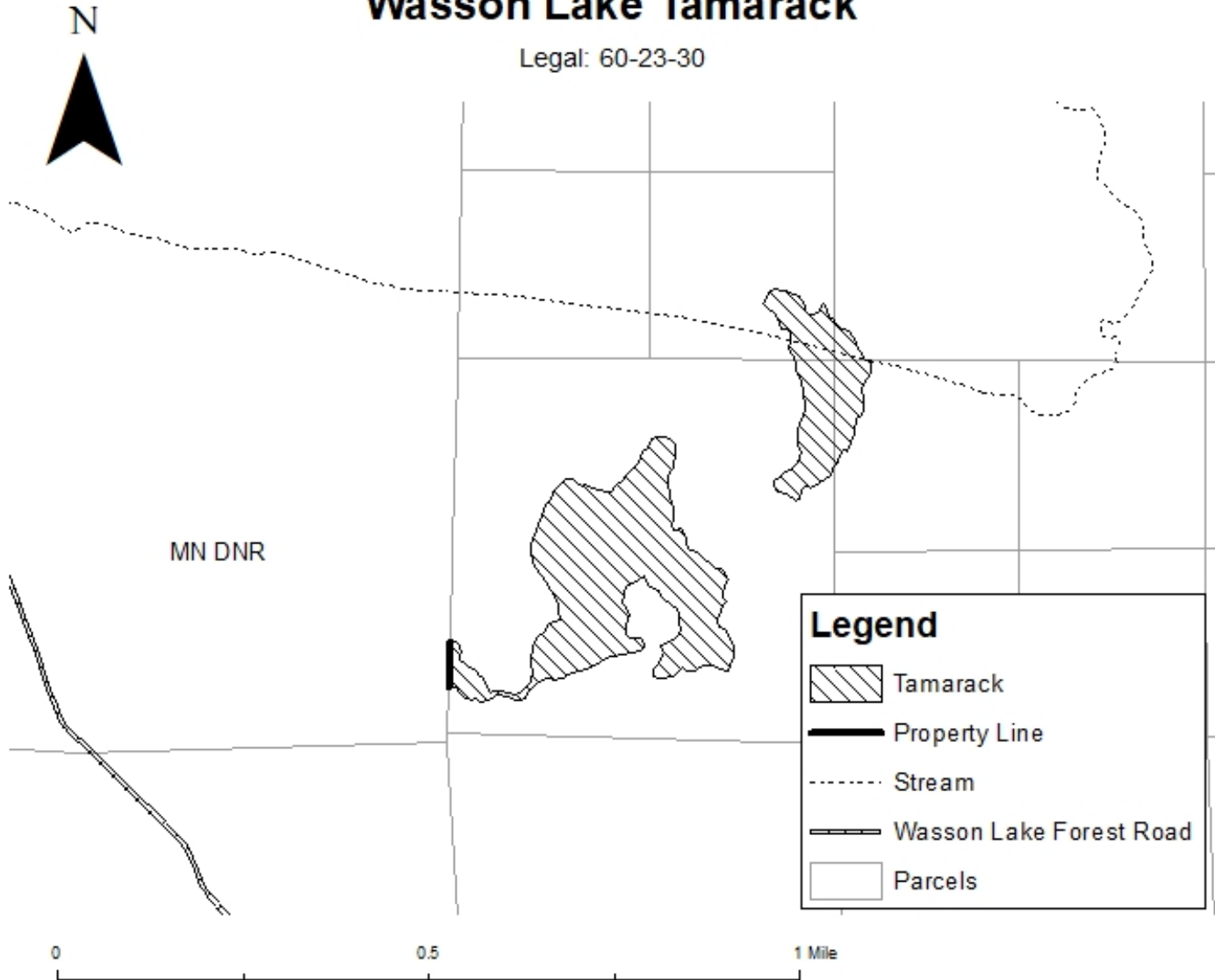
