Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all white pine, red pine <11", maple, and non-hazardous snags.

Access

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

Gates must remain locked during hunting season.

State land must be crossed to access this timber sale. Logger must obtain permission from the land manager.

.5-2.4 miles to Co. Rd. 53.

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Landings and Access Roads

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15 ft. of the snowmobile trail.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

There is 3 acres of red pine to thin. Thin stand down to an average of 110 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees.

Sale boundaries are painted in orange or blue. There are also natural boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all non-timbered wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout the aspen, tamarack, and spruce types.

Slash is to be piled on the jack pine types. 20% of tops and limbs must be scattered throughout the permit area per Site Level Forest Management Guideline. The 20% is in addition to incidental breakage.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along the snowmobile trail.


