Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Timber must be processed at the stump.

Do not damage reserve trees.

On 1st time thins - cut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Thin stand down to an average of 90 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and trees overtopping the red pine.

On second time thins: thin stands down to 100 basal area by removing smaller, poor quality trees, and other species.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries painted in orange or are natural boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

A 20 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along Co. Rd. 7.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along all other roads and trails.

Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.

Special Conditions

Utilize all trees with at least 2 sticks up to a 3" top.

Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during May through September.


