**Harvest and Reserves** 

Reserve cedar, Y. birch, pine, small balsam, cavity trees and all non-hazardous snags.

**Access** 

Gate must be locked each evening, but can be left open during the days when 3 or more loads are hauled.

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

State land (portion of access rd.) must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permission from land manager.

**Landings and Access Roads** 

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.

#### Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage regeneration/ reserve trees or fell timber across sale boundaries.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Most sale boundaries painted orange, but some natural cutting boundaries.

Ash type shown on map - cut mechantable ash 3 sticks and greater, elsewhere on sale, cut ash greater than 9" dbh.

#### Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Roads and skid trails must be stablized. This may involve installing water bars, strike outs, and/or mulching and seeding.

#### Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


