Harvest and Reserves

Harvest: Cut all unmarked aspen, balm, ash, maple.

Reserve trees marked with an "R" and all oak, elm, spruce; reserve birch/basswood < 6".

Reserve 1 well formed birch every 80 feet. If no birch available reserve a well formed Basswood or Maple in its place.

Access

Gated Federal roads must be used to access timber sale. Logger must abide by terms of road use permit.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage "R" marked reserve trees or reserve species.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across ownership boundaries.

Harvest & wetland/legacy boundaries painted with orange lines; property lines painted orange circles.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands and ash flowage marked with "R" trees in center.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

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Slash Disposal

Slash must be scattered throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

Timber is overmature and susceptible to windthrow damage.

Loads with mixed species will be scaled as the highest value species unless the consumer scales species separately using County approved methods.

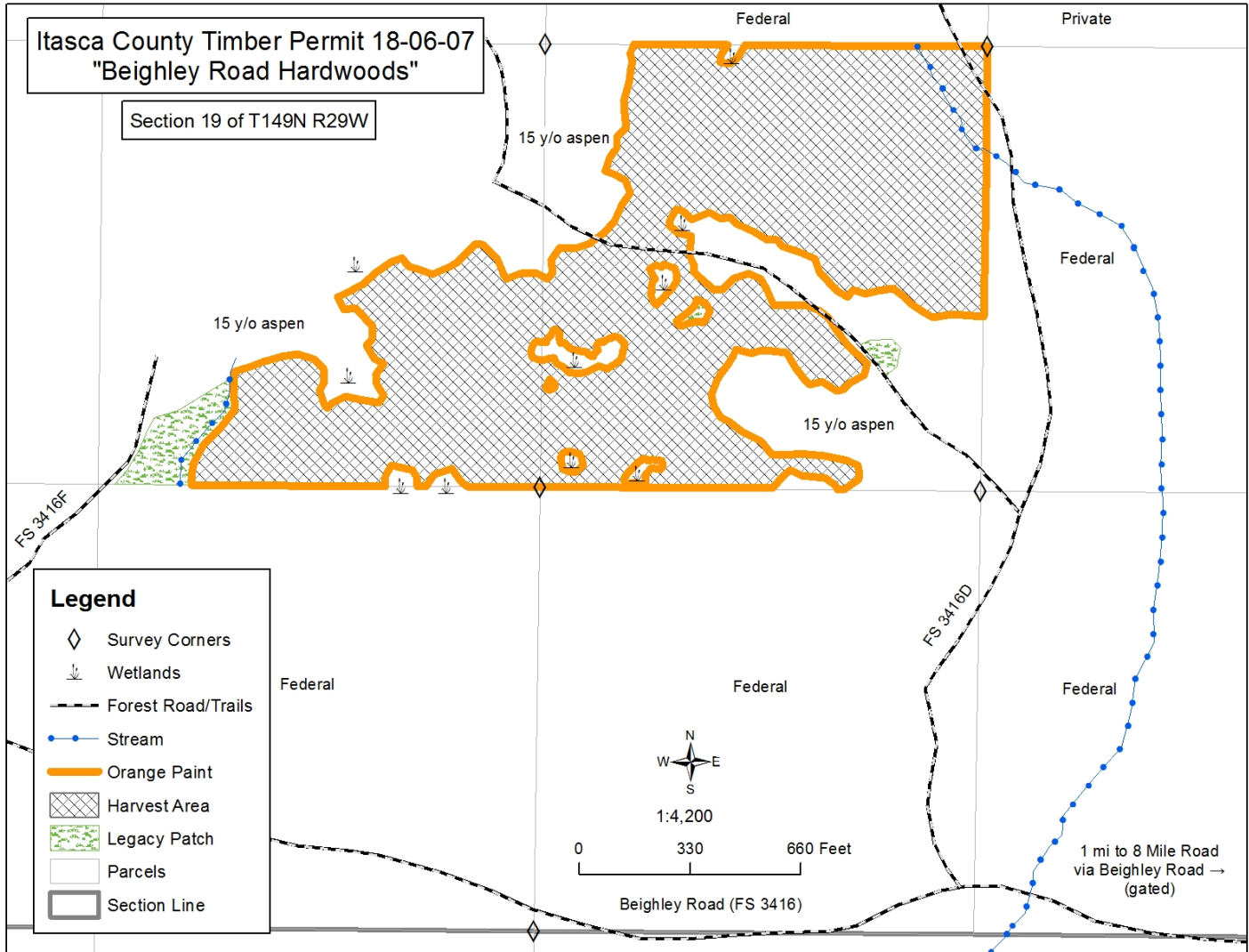
Regeneration Plan
