Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale boundaries painted Orange Slashes (III) shown on map. All other boundaries are natural.

### Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

### Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.


