Harvest and Reserves

Comments

Harvest: clearcut all aspen, spruce, balsam, ash and balm.

Reserve: Reserve patches of aspen and balsam regeneration (<5") and all birch, maple, elm, and trees marked with "R--R". Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access

New winter road and snow approach to be constructed off Hwy 65 to facilitate future public access to timber. Grown over section line road and driveway to north is private property.

1/4-3/4 miles to public road State Hwy 65.

DOT permit may be required for snow approach off State Hwy.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Sale boundaries painted with orange lines (I I I). Natural boundary is used on all blocks; see sale map.

Itasca County forestlands are Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Certified by NEPCon, NC-FM/COC-1709; FSC 100%


