1st time white spruce thin(9 acres), 1st time red pine/birch thin(6 acres), and aspen clearcut(9 acres).

Harvest and Reserves

In the aspen type, reserve all pine, oak, maple, non-merchantable balsam, and non-hazardous snags.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

White spruce and red pine/birch types: cut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Thin stands down to an average of 90 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, damaged, and trees over topping the spruce or red pine crop trees.

Clearcut the aspen type except for the reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries are painted in orange or or natural boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout the permit area or in rows made by the cut-to-lenght system.


