Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all white pine, oak, and non-hazardous snags. In the aspen stands also reserve the red pine and non-merchantable conifers.

Access

Private / Easement road must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition at all times.

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

Gate must be locked at all times, except on days when 3 or more loads are hauled.

ATV trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply.

Landings and Access Roads

Landings must be kept back at least 100' from ATV and snowmobile trail.

The ATV and snowmobile trail is rocky and can get wet. The road is hard to crown or even smooth out. It may need a few loads of gravel if it starts to get in bad shape.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries are painted in blue or are natural boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 60' of all wetlands.

Roads and skid trails must be stablized. This may involve installing water bars, strike outs, and/or mulching and seeding.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout the aspen types.

In the red pine types, slash is to be piled at administrator approved locations. 20% of tops and limbs must be scattered throughout the permit area per Site Level Forest Management Guideline. The 20% is in addition to incidental breakage.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Regeneration Plan

The aspen types will be naturally regenerated to aspen and the red pine types will be planted to red pine.


