Access

Comments

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

State land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permission from the land manager.

Landings and Access Roads

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage red pine crop trees.

Thin stand down to an average of 100 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees. There are existing cut rows to follow.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries are all natural boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 60' of all wetlands and river.

Slash Disposal

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.

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
Special Conditions


Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.
