Harvest Specifications Comments 2ND TIME RED PINE THIN. Harvest and Reserves Reserve oak, white pine, and all non-hazardous snags. Access Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface. 0-1 mile to Co. Rd. 52.

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Landings and Access Roads

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve crop trees.

Thin stand down to 100-110 basal area. Favor the removal of other tree species, smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees. Use cut strips to access timber.

Sale boundaries painted in orange or are natural boundaries..

Slash Disposal

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of Co. Rd. 52.

Special Conditions


Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.

Site "A" and the east part of site "B" can only be cut after August 1 due to 2 Goshawk nests.
