Harvest Type: Aspen and Black Spruce clearcuts.

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snag and cavity trees, cedar, small balsam and advanced regeneration pockets. Reserve any unmerchantible trees within 30' of Bower Lake Forest Road right of way.

Access

2 miles to maintained public road (#583) to west.

Landings and Access Roads

Landings must be kept back at least 100' from the Bower Lk Forest Road and must be pre- approved by sale administrator.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Majority of cutting boundaries painted orange. The north 1/2 of line on the west side of the black spruce type has natural cutting boundaries.

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Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area. No upland slash to remain in black spruce or lowland areas. Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road and 20' slash free zone to be left along the road right of way.

Special Conditions

All Black Spruce stems greater than 5ft. must be severed to aid in Dwarf Mistletoe prevention.

Regeneration Plan

Natural Regeneration of aspen and black spruce. Aerial seeding of the black spruce area will also be recommended to aid in regeneration.

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
