Access from County Road 52 approximately 1 mile north along woods road to permit area. Road accesses private property that must remain open to highway vehicles. Caution truck hauling signs must be posted.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Sale boundary painted blue. In the white spruce stand cut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Thin stand down to an average of 90 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees. The black spruce type requires clearcut harvest.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

There is a small 1'-2' wide intermittent creek / drainage on the north side of the white spruce thin area. Any tree tops or slash that falls into this area must be hauled back into permit area.


The black spruce area should be seeded back to black spruce to insure full stocking potentional of this site.
