Harvest Type: Clearcut w/reserves(37.21 AC), Ash thin(20.09 AC) & Black Spruce Clearcut(5.71 AC)

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Aspen Clearcut: Harvest Aspen, Balm, Ash and Balsam Fir >3 Sticks. Reserve Balsam Fir <2 sticks and all Birch, Maple, Elm and Spruce. Harvest all ash within 30 feet of aspen type.

Black Spruce Clearcut: Harvest all Black Spruce and Tamarack. Reserve Birch, Elm and Ash.

Ash Thin: Cut strips 20 feet wide with 40 feet between the strips.

Access

Possible access is across Blandin land. Another option in an approach of Hwy 6 near the NW portion of the timber sale across Itasca County land.

DOT permit may be required to access timber sale off State HWY. Permit Holder needs to secure permission.

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Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Property lines are painted with Orange Circles. Cutting Boundries are either painted with orange slashes or are a natural boundary.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Special Conditions

All Black Spruce stems greater than 5ft. must be severed. Mistletoe prevention

Regeneration Plan

Natural Regeneration in aspen and ash types, Black Spruce type will be aerial seeded along with any natural regeneration.


