Spruce thin: Cut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Thin stand down to an average of 90 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees.

Aspen Clearcut: Harvest all Aspen, Ash and Paper Birch. Reserve all Oak, Maple, Pine and Elm.

Harvest and Reserves

Aspen Clearcut: Reserve all Oak, Maple, Pine and Elm.

Spruce Thin: Reserve Elm, Pine, Oak and aspen that is not overtoping spruce.

Access

Private land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land owner/ land manager.

Landings and Access Roads

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Within Spruce thin timber must be processed at the stump.

Do not damage unmarked trees, regeneration, or reserve trees.


