Comments Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut (24.89 ac) and Ash Strip Thin (4 Ac)

Harvest and Reserves

Aspen Block: Harvest all aspen, balm, birch, basswood and ash. Reserve oak, maple, and pine.

Ash block: Cut 40 foot strips reserving 40 foot between strips harvesting only ash. Reserve everything but ash

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all roads.

Landings must be kept back at least 100' from Frazer Road.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.


