**Harvest Specifications**

Comments
Harvest type: Overstory removal

Harvest and Reserves
Reserve all non-hazardous snags. Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife. Cut all stems within permit area.

Access
Harvest area is around the Big Ridge Cross Country Ski Trail. Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface. 0.5 miles to public road County Road 560.

Landings and Access Roads
Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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### Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.  
 Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.  
 Harvest boundaries painted orange paint. Natural (No Paint) boundaries also exist on this permit.

### Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

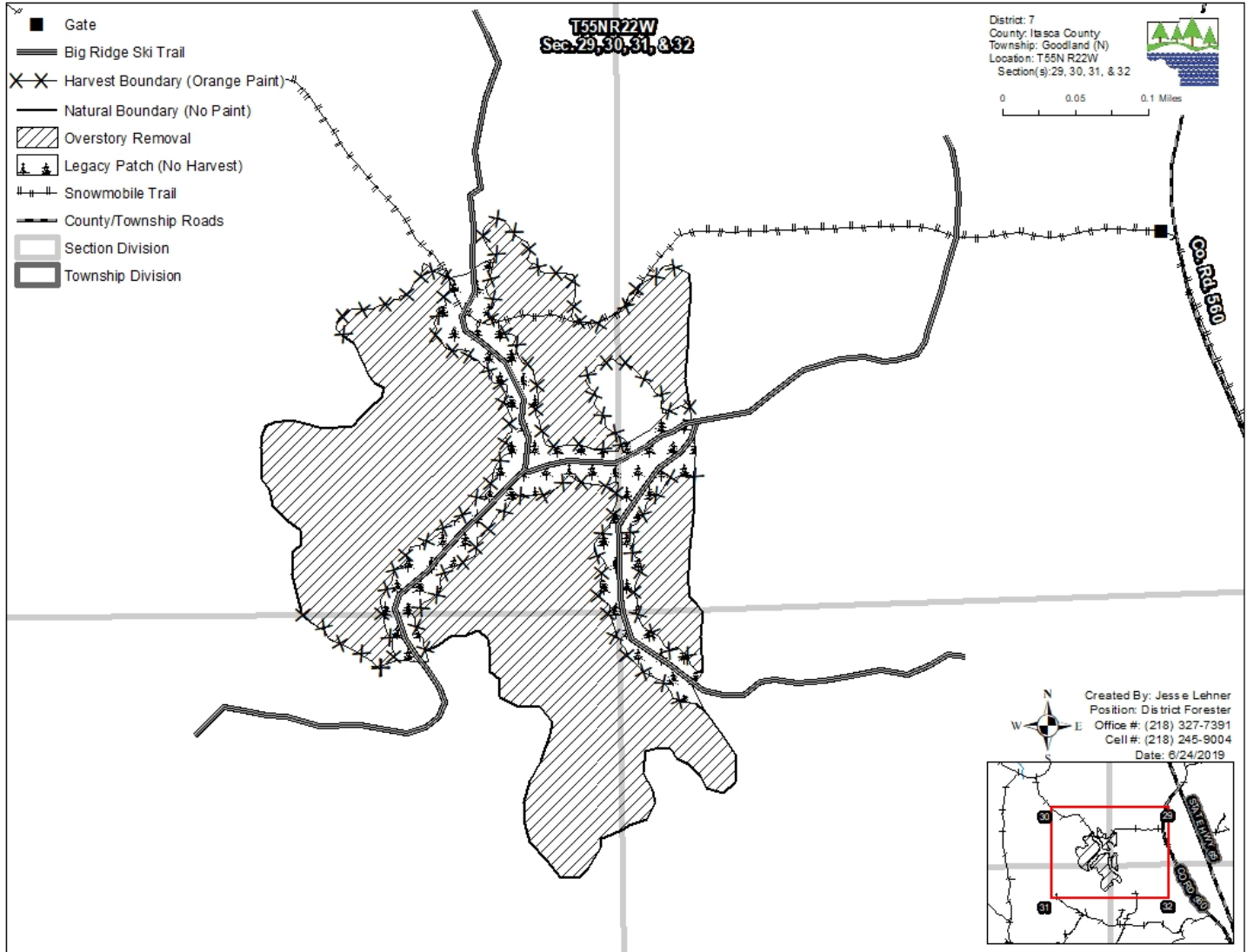
### Regeneration Plan
