Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all conifers, oak, elm, ash, maple, birch < 8" and non-hazardous snags.

Access

Blandin road must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition, as determined by administering forester, at all times. Blandin forester Greg Dewey has given permission to access, but wants to be notified before starting the timber sale.

Gate must be locked at all times, except on days when 3 or more loads are hauled.

Gates must remain locked during hunting season.

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface. Landing will not be allowed on this trail during the snowmobile season.

ATV trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. Forester will post "logging ahead" and "caution: trucks hauling" signs. Landing will not be allowed on this trail during the ATV season.

Landings and Access Roads

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all trails.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.


