2nd Entry Red Pine Thin (Operator Select).

Access

Sale is on a State forest road (Stingy Lake), about 1/2 mile south of County maintained #527 (Rearing Pond Rd.).

Landings and Access Roads

Use existing access road. Berm to be replaced upon completion of sale activities.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Timber must be processed at the stump.

Use existing clearcut strips and thin from below 20' each side to 90-100BA. Remove aspen and jack pine when competing with red pine crop trees. Remove smaller diameter, poor formed and any damaged (porcupine, etc) trees first.

East sale boundary painted orange. Remainder of sale to use natural cutting boundaries.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Special Conditions

Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.


