Harvest Specifications

Comments

Black spruce clearcut (37.8 acres), aspen (18 acres) and jack pine (4 acres) clearcuts with reserves.

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve small balsam, cedar, birch, ash, red/white pine and snag/cavity trees when not a hazard.

Access

State land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land manager.

1 mile to County #554 (if using the shortest route to sale area).

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Keep upland slash in upland areas and do not fell trees outside sale boundaries.

Majority of sale boundaries are painted orange.

Black spruce 5-7" stands have about 30BA (3-4"dbh) of unmerchantible trees that will require felling.

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all lowland brush wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

All Black Spruce stems greater than 5ft. must be severed for Dwarf Mistletoe control.

Utilize spruce and tamarack 5" DBH and greater with 2 sticks to a 3" top.


