White spruce/red pine operator-select thin (35 acres) and jack pine clearcut with reserves (6 acres).

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access

Access from Bearville Road 528 unto existing forest trail into permit area.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be approved by sale administrator. Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester before performance bond is returned.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Cut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Thin stand down to an average of 90 basal area in the white spruce and 110 basal area in the red pine. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, and damaged trees. Parts of sale boundary painted orange rest natural boundaries. Clearcut 6 acre jack pine stand painted orange in the southeast.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area. Maintain a 10' slash free zone along road.

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Regeneration Plan

Site prep and replant the jack pine site back to jack pine.


