Aspen Clearcut W/Reserves

#### **Harvest and Reserves**

Harvest Aspen, balm and Balsam along with any W. Spruce 3 sticks and bigger. Reserve Oak, Maple, Birch, Pine, Ash, and Spruce 2 sticks and smaller.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

#### **Access**

Access is down the newly built "Rain Barrel" road starting on County Rd 60 (Clearwater Road). The road crosses state and tax forfeit lands. Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

#### **Landings and Access Roads**

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

Roughly a 1/4 mile of new summer road would need to be built in order to access the sale in nonfrozen conditions.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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### Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Do not damage reserve trees.

Sale property boundaries are painted with orange circles.

Sale cutting boundaries are painted with orange or blue slashes

### Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Dry summer operable site with interuptions due to wet weather conditions. Extreme care will be needed to safely harvest site during nonfrozen conditions.

## Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

No snags shall be left within a tree length distance to the snowmobile trail


